*Breed Back Yes or No

**This will allow a breed back in 2026 if the mare does not conceive, aborts the fetus, or does not produce a live foal which stands and nurses in 2026. Applicable only if the stallion is standing at the same farm in 2026.*

- **SPECIAL INCENTIVE:** A \$1,500 bonus will be paid to the stallion farm or donator of the stallion season, whose progeny are declared the official winner of the 2029 Nebraska HBPA Stallion Stakes.
- ALL foals born in 2026, regardless of what state they are foaled in, are eligible to nominate to the 2029 Nebraska HBPA Stallion Stakes for 3-year olds.
- All sale prices will be kept STRICTLY CONFIDENTIAL between the buyer, the seller, and the Nebraska HBPA.
- Seasons will be sold online through www.thoroughlybred.com, ending on January 2nd, 2025.
- Donations are not split with the season donor and/or stallion owner. Only 100% donation seasons accepted.
- Bidding will begin at \$400 unless a higher reserve is set. Any reserve must be in writing. Reserves are defined as "the minimum a season may be sold for".
- Proceeds from the 2025 Nebraska HBPA Stallion Auction will be solely designated to the Nebraska HBPA Stallion Stakes for 3-year-olds in 2029.
- You can provide up to five pictures to be used on website and provide a link to the stallion's page and/or farm website.
- **REPURCHASE:** If a stallion goes through the online auction and does not sell, the owner or season donator may repurchase the season for the repurchase price of \$400 to make progeny eligible for nomination to The Nebraska HBPA Stallion Stakes in 2026.
- The donor may bid on his/her own stallion.

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF SALE:

- The Stallion owner nominates his/her Stallion Progeny for the Nebraska HBPA Stallion Stakes for 3-year olds in 2029. Said Stallion Service shall be auctioned by the Nebraska HBPA and upon successful sale of the Stallion Service, all foals conceived in 2025 & foaled in 2026 are automatically eligible for nomination to the Nebraska HBPA Stallion Stakes in 2029.
- Proceeds from the 2025 Nebraska HBPA Stallion Auction will be primarily designated to the Nebraska HBPA Stallion Stakes in 2029.
- The Nebraska HBPA acts as an agent only and will endeavor to protect the interest of both the buyer and Stallion owner. It is the buyer's responsibility to contact the Stallion farm & to understand any fees which may or may not be listed in this auction.
- Minimum bid \$400 or the reserve established by the Stallion owner. Minimum bid will be set at whichever is greater.
- Should the Stallion become deceased or become unfit for breeding purposes before the winning bidder's mare has been serviced, **contact the Nebraska HBPA immediately**. The Nebraska HBPA will handle each issue on an individual case basis and will always verify the Stallion is deceased or has become unfit for breeding. **YOU MUST NOTIFY THE NEBRASKA HBPA BY JULY 15TH OF THAT BREEDING YEAR.** No cases will be considered after July 15th of that breeding year.
- Stallion owner is not responsible for any disease, accident, sickness and/or death of a mare or foal and similarly mare owner will not be responsible for any disease, accident, or sickness and/or death of the Stallion.
- Mare, in order to qualify for breeding must be halter broke and have a current negative Coggins and/or uterine culture as required by the Stallion owner.
- A Stallion Service Certificate will be provided to the mare owner from the Stallion owner upon payment in full of all board, veterinarian, or other services upon the birth of a live foal. It is the mare owner's responsibility to contact the Stallion owner to receive the Stallion Service Certificate.
- Membership in good standing with the Nebraska Thoroughbred Breeders Association is required to purchase a stallion season.
- Sale of the dam before foaling or sale of the foal after nomination has been completed will not affect the eligibility of the foal. The new owner will be responsible for any remaining nomination fees due in order to remain eligible to the Nebraska HBPA Stallion Stakes.
- There will be NO substitutions for an entry.
- Stallion owners have the option to buy their Stallion Season back at the minimum bid, if he does not sell, to make his foals eligible.
